The recent coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic has affected everybody, and our society is no exception. We strongly believe that during this difficult time we need to stay connected, support each other, and educate young marine biotechnology researchers. Last year the ESMB society launched a series of webinars from leading researchers in the field of marine biotechnology. We continue these webinars during this year. The topics of webinars ranged from wood eaters, novel marine nutraceuticals and

bioprospecting to Nagoya protocol. The webinars are free to attend and their recording can be found on our society's website. We hope these webinars will act as a platform for promoting and further enhancing collaborations while offering a window to new developments and stimulate interesting scientific conversations.

Thus, we have opened the placement service again, and will encourage planning of placements for the academic year 2021-2022.

ESMB CONFERENCE

Scientific conferences are important moments for discussion of results, both paramount and recent progresses in the field, but also for networking. The COVID-19 pandemic has been changing this panorama and different models have been implemented since its outbreak: initial postponing of all events has been progressively substituted by virtual and hybrid events.

Believing on the power of face-to-face networking, namely providing opportunity for students and young researchers to meet senior scientists, the ESMB continues the efforts for the organization of a physical international conference on marine biotechnology. However, given the different national situations regarding health and safety and the uncertainties for the future, despite the progress achieved so far, namely with vaccination, it was decided to postpone once more the event, to November 2022. Stay tuned for further news.

This event aims to trigger the regular organization of a congress of the European Society for Marine Biotechnology. Proposals for the organization of next editions are welcome.

ESMB MINI-SYMPOSIUM

While the contingency measures to stop COVID-19 are facing different developments across Europe and traveling is not yet stabilized, the European Society for Marine Biotechnology is organizing an online mini-symposium for students in marine biotechnology. The goal is to give an opportunity for young researchers to discuss their work and progress on marine biotechnology with other colleagues and start building their own relations within this community. This on-line event will take place on Friday, 26th of November 2021.

The undergraduate and postgraduate students who would like to deliver a talk should fill the form and submit an abstract, following this <u>link</u>.

OTHER CONFERENCES AND WORKSHOPS

ESMB endorses other events organized by their associates or highly relevant for the field, upon analysis of the board. In the same line, it also interacts with other organizations in the sector and, in this regard, the 13th International Marine Biotechnology Conference (http://theimba.org/), to be held in July 2023, will take place in Brest, France, under the organization of Claire Hellio, ESMB Board Member.

The history of this conference starts back in 1989, in Tokyo, Japan, and since then has been joining together the world leaders in the field, with support from both the private and public sectors, with events occurring in different locations around the globe.

Besides, other events are endorsed by ESMB. One of these events took place last summer:

LIPIDS IN THE OCEAN. Structure, function, ecological role and applications

5-7 July 2021, Aveiro, Portugal

This event was a great opportunity for researchers, students and stakeholders to share their knowledge, expertise and new ideas on marine lipids and advance our knowledge on the study and potential applications of these biomolecules. Lipids play a key role when aiming to understand complex trophic-interactions in the marine realm, as they allow to shed light over the recurrent question of "who is eating what". Marine lipids can also reveal local to regional adaptations of marine organisms to



shifting biotic and abiotic conditions, a feature of extreme relevance if one considers the ongoing changes on the oceans of today and tomorrow. These molecules allow researchers to work at multiple organizational levels, from unicellular marine organisms to the functioning of whole ecosystem.

Webinars

ESMB WEBINARS

The ESMB Webinar series has progressed, contributing to the training of students and professionals operating in Marine Biotechnology sector, being moments of fruitful discussion and knowledge consolidation.

Topics are quite diverse, given the broadness offered by marine biodiversity, technologies and applications, from microbe-deriving bioactive compounds and marine origin materials to new aquaculture technology or mitigation of pollution on aquatic ecosystems, among many more.

The **third webinar**, held in 19th of January 2021, brought us two speakers, Dr. Narcisa M. Bandarra and Ena Pritišanac. Dr. Narcisa M. Bandarra is Head of Aquaculture, Upgrading and Bioprospecting Division from Portuguese Institute for the Sea and Atmosphere, I.P. (IPMA), with extensive experience in the upgrading of fishery and aquaculture products with special focus on biochemical and nutritional value, and talked about "Bioprospecting and nutritional approaches: marine bioactive compounds towards human health benefits".

<u>Ena Pritišanac</u> is a research assistant in the Laboratory of Marine Ecotoxicology at the Centre for Marine Research in Rovinj and doctoral student of Oceanology at the Faculty of Science in Zagreb, Croatia, working on laboratory cultivation and analytical assays of phytoplankton. She talked about "Biomass productivity and lipid accumulation of three marine microalgae grown in oil refinery wastewater".

The **fourth webinar**, held in 22nd of April 2021, was presented by Prof. Jeanette Hammer Andersen, taking on "From Sustainable Resources to novel marine nutraceuticals for the management of Metabolic Syndrome – The SuReMetS Project".

Prof. Jeanette Hammer Andersen is a professor in marine bioprospecting at University of Tromso (UiT), in Norway,

- post-graduation and advanced courses on marine biotechnology and associated specific fields;
- opportunities for training periods, internships and fellowships at international labs, under the scope of research projects in which marine biotechnology plays a pivotal role.

Besides, there is also an opportunity to place a request for training not available among the listed proposals.
